Andy Goldsworthy is a British sculptor, photographer and environmentalist. He lives in Scotland. He uses **natural materials** to make sculptures in sites in and around the UK. He has made them in forests, farms, fields, cities, mountains and more. He often uses curves, spirals, holes and arches in his artwork. Sometimes they last for a long time, other times they last only days.
